Consultation on the Town Council's Business Plan 2019-2023.

We have refreshed our Council Business Plan and we now want to hear what you think.

Penrith Town Council's Business Plan will influence the budget process. It has accommodated emerging feedback from the information gathered from the consultation for the Penrith Neighbourhood Development Plan.

The Town Council are consulting on each of the six priorities in the Business Plan and will include the analysis of public feedback in a report to full Council on 23rd September. When the Plan is formally resolved by full Council, it will be used as a formal document. The consultation closes on 9 September 2019.
