Gone but not Forgotten

On Sunday 8th November, Penrith remembered those who had fallen in all conflicts in a very different way. Penrith Town Council had arranged that individuals representing those organisation usually invited to attend the civic service and parade, laid wreaths over a two hour period and at 5 minute intervals to observe social distancing and follow the requirements set out in the regulations issued by the Government the previous Monday.

At 11am the church bell tolled whilst the last Post was played by Chris Ford from Penrith Town Band before Rev David Sargeant read out the Citation. This was followed by Reveille in a very short but poignant section of the day which was live streamed onto social media.
